# LEWISBERRY BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING MONDAY, APRIL 6, 2009

The meeting was called to order by William H. Thompson leading in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

## MEMBERS PRESENT

## PUBLIC PRESENT

## RECOGNITION OF PUBLIC

- Byron Trout of Gordon Brown's office presented the following items:
  - o Byron Trout explained there are two options for the storm sewer problem on Front Street.
    - 1) Option one would have an approximate cost of \$24,770.00 using Type M inlet.
    - 2) Option two would have an approximate cost of \$26,470.00 using Type C inlet. Both options include tapping into Heck Hill inlet and any repairs to sidewalks including the brick sidewalk in front of the Thompson residence.
      - Both options would require advertising for bids due to the fact the price will be over \$10,000.
      - o Sandra Griffith made the motion and David Raugh seconded to begin the process for bid and to apply for County aid of \$10,000.00. Motion carried.
  - O Byron Trout also explained additional Fema requirements with a deadline of September 25<sup>th</sup> for the Borough to have an ordinance adopted for flood plain management. He highly recommends Lewisberry adopt the York County's ordinance. DCED will send notification to the Borough's solicitor explaining the process to him and supplying a model ordinance. The ordinance must be passed and forwarded to DCED by August 25<sup>th</sup>, 2009. FEMA completed new flood mapping defining the floodway; therefore Lewisberry went from area C to an area D.
  - O Gordon Brown explained to Council there are grants available for refurbishing the Borough Park Building; however, the scope of the project and costs must be determined prior to applying for any grants. William Thompson appointed a committee of David Raugh, Mary Pelton, Sandra Griffith and David Iddings to work with Gordon Brown on this project. A committee meeting is scheduled on April 9<sup>th</sup> @ 8:00 at the Borough Park Building.
- Mark Albright, Lewisberry Fire Company reported the following:
  - o The Fire Company has been busy responding to calls since the beginning of the year.
  - Mark also will remind Jennifer to forward the insurance information requested by Borough Manager.

#### RECOGNITION OF PUBLIC, CONTINUED

- Newberry Township Police Chief John Snyder reported the following:
  - There were twenty (20) incidents in the Borough in March.
  - o Chief Snyder introduced Sergeant Jay Smith, Newberry Township's canine officer.
  - The police force will be doing night patrols on foot and also bike patrols in the Borough.
  - o Newberry Township accreditation is now on the police cars.
  - O David Iddings has requested more patrols in the park.
