LEWISBERRY BOROUGH COUNCIL MEETING MONDAY APRIL 12, 2010

The meeting was called to order by David Raugh leading in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

RECOGNITION OF PUBLIC

- Gary Smith, Red Land Food Ministry representative presented a drawing describing and showing their request to increase the storage in the rear parking lot of the Borough Building at no cost to the Borough. David Raugh questioned the insurance on the building contents and Mr. Smith explained the ministry covers the contents and also pays the electric. When doing this, the Ministry would also extend the sidewalk and add parking spaces if required by the Borough. Discussion ensued. Borough Council agrees the Food Ministry provides a necessary community service and would like to see it succeed; however, the location is not acceptable to the Borough. Daniel <u>SOLTIS</u> made a motion which was seconded by Mary <u>PELTON</u> to not permit the Red Land Food Ministry their request for additional use of the back Community Building parking lot. Motion carried, 6-0.
- Delores Struck, resident, voiced her concern with Mr. Konevich's property including the parking of the Konevich Sign truck close to the stop sign and the Terranetti's box truck parked also along Market Street close to the intersection. Mrs. Struck requested Council to rectify the hazardous situations and they assured her they would look into the matter.

SOLICITOR'S REPORT

• John Elliott, solicitor was absent; however, Mary Ellen Banks, Borough Manager reported on his behalf in reference to disconnecting electricity during winter months. Explaining via email, the Lewisberry Electric Company is not governed by the PUC and in addition no currently contemplated shut-offs would need special handling since the period of special winter termination rules runs from December 1 thru March 31.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

• Mark <u>KEENER</u> made a motion which was seconded by Edward <u>FARR</u> to approve the minutes of the March 1, 2010 meeting. Motion carried, 6-0.

INVOICES AND RECEIPTS

• Mark <u>KEENER</u> made a motion which was seconded by Mary <u>PELTON</u> to approve the General Fund, Electric Fund and Road Fund invoices for payment. Motion carried, 6-0.

Mayor's Report

- Matt Kiner reported on the following:
 - He is continuing to monitor the situation concerning the Konevich property; however, the number of vehicles varies from day to day and all are registered. In additional there does not appear to be an ordinance limiting the number of vehicles on a property.
 - The information concerning the PA Right to Know Act is now on the Borough Web Site.

Road Committee

• David Raugh explained the Borough was not permitted previously to do changes on Front Street due to the fact that it was a state road. However, since it is no longer a state road, the Borough could possibly post "local traffic only" in the winter. He also requested Daniel Solis begin working on this project with the residents now so it will be completed before the winter storms.

Electric Committee

- Mark Keener reported/requested the following:
 - Council gave permission to have Henkle and McCoy inspect the pole at Walnut Lane and South Street to determine if it needs replaced.
 - He informed Council the Motto rental property owner will complete the sidewalk repair.
 - He would also like to request increasing the late fee from a 10% penalty to a 15% penalty. This request was tabled to be reviewed by the solicitor.
- David Raugh presented and read a sample resolution from AMP requesting the Borough's support of SB168 legislation allowing for take-or-pay contracts for generation projects. The resolution is in support for this bill to be brought up for a vote. It passed the Senate by a unanimous vote and is currently stuck in the House Local Government Committee. Daniel <u>SOLTIS</u> made a motion which was seconded by Mary <u>PELTON</u> to have the resolution prepared. Motion carried, 6-0.

Library Committee

• Sandra Griffith informed council the Library had a book, bake and soup sale. There will be a sub sale next month and August 7th is the chili cook-off at the Borough Park.

Insurance Committee

• The Committee met with the H.A. Thomson representative for the annual review.

Park Committee

• David Raugh reported the drywall in the front right corner of the Borough Park Building will be removed and inspected and the vent on the second floor will be replaced by Thomas Banks.

Planning Committee - No Report

Red Land Community Corporation

- Discussion ensued concerning access to the offices in this building and keys to these same areas.
- Mary Ellen Banks explained there is now security in this building when Red Cap is open and she also explained she does not think this is necessary. Discussion ensued.

- Council members explained that Penn Waste is collecting trash previous to the 7:00 agreed upon time. Dave Raugh will call Penn Waste once again.
