### Insurance Commission:

- The final agreed upon cost for the Fire Station repairs is \$188,000.00 for the building itself and another \$55,000.00 in code upgrades.
- There was also a loss of approximately five (5) Tables and seven (7) chairs and two (2) mats that we have asked the insurance company to replace; those items are not covered by insurance.
- During the repairs to the Fire Station there were some scratches made to the tile flooring. Stripper was applied to the scratches and then waxed which has left the scratches to now be white and more noticeable. Discussion ensued. Council decides to leave the floor as is.

## **Building and Grounds Commission:**

Councilman Robert Smith stated the following:

- · Park Building:
  - The Borough's landscaping company was contacted to remind them not to discharge grass onto the Softball Fields.
  - o Fuel Oil tank 1/2.
- Fire Station:
  - o The new Electric Meter has been installed in the Engine Room.
- Community Building:
  - o Jim Hamburger of the Health Center requested a hand pull fire alarm be installed and two Fire Drills to be performed a year. Per code, the Borough is not required to have a hand pull fire alarm.

#### **OLD BUSINESS**

• President William Thompson stated there seems to be no issues with the Fire Station Parking trial for borough residents, Mr. Thompson will continue to monitor the parking and keep council informed.

#### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Manager Greene stated Donald Keener of Newberry Township has been contacted by York Haven stating their desire to utilize Newberry Townships EMA services, which would adversely affect the Borough as a new Agreement would have to be drawn up incurring costs. Discussion ensued. Decision tabled until further information can be obtained.
- William Thompson stated the following:
  - York County Quick Response Team is looking for funding from municipalities to help aid in their temporary and long term expenses. Discussion ensued. President Thompson will speak with Newberry in regards to this.
  - Council Members should have received a letter from the Department of Health and Human Services notifying them that York County residents will be asked to take part in a survey.
